Regular Meeting of September 12, 2011

The WISD Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 12, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of holding a regular meeting. Action Items:

- The Board approved the District and Campus Improvement Plans

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof; as the School Board shall determine.
